MEALS DURING SCHOOL CLOSURE

The Winn Parish School Board will be providing take out breakfast and lunch to all Winn Parish children under the age of 18.

Starting Monday, March 23rd, parents will be able to drive to the designated feeding sites for breakfast and lunch between the hours of 9:30-11:00 am to pick up bagged meals. Both breakfast and lunch will be served at the same time (2 meals). Families will not need to enter the school building or exit the car as part of site protocols.

The following sites will be open March 23rd, Monday – Friday through April 3rd. No meals will be served during Easter break the week of April 6-13th.
